

Announcement of Uniquest Mahasarakham University Subject: No Gift Policy

In reference to an announcement from the Office of Prime Minister on the subject of 'An Announcement of National Reform Plan (Revised Edition)', issued on February 23rd, 2021, under the National Reform Plan on Prevention, Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (Revised Edition), a drive to develop Thai bureaucracy is determined to be unprofitably transparent. Regarding objective 1 item 1.1, every state agency must declare itself as an organization with all its staff refraining from all kinds of presents and gifts by their duty performances (or No Gift Policy).

Hence, to drive activities of reform under the National Reform Plan above; to establish transparency within the agency, to shape values of performing duties, and to practice an honest culture, Uniquest declares to all executives, administrators, and staff of the university refraining from inquiries of all kinds of presents and gifts by their duty performances (or No Gift Policy); on all celebrations and special occasions. Aside from an inevitable occurrence, he/she must follow the rules of present or gift acceptance or other benefits, under the regulations of the Office of Prime Minister on the subject of giving or accepting gifts to government officers 2001; announced by the National Anti-Corruption Commissioners on the subject of 'Rules of Property or Other Profit Acceptancy toward the Government Officer's Ethics 2020.'

This announcement will accordingly be informed to all executives, employees, administrators, and staff in the university conscientiously following the policy.
